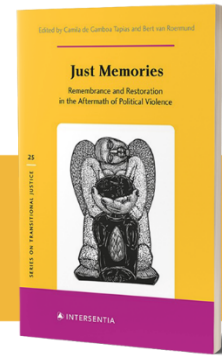

Participants will be given the opportunity to ask questions and to participate in the discussion. Questions may be sent in in advance.

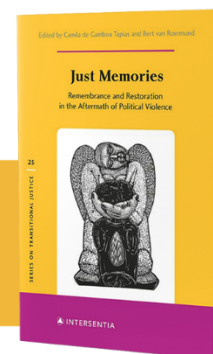
